In order to graduate, all students are required to:

1) Meet the credit requirement and complete the core courses as reflected in the below chart;
2) Complete a senior thesis with a grade of C - or higher; and
3) Either of the following: Score at least 500 on the math section of the SAT, score at least 50 on the AFQT (Armed Services

Vocational Aptitude Battery), or complete a math capstone.
In the following chart, one credit is equivalent to one year of study (or two semesters).

| Latin/Foreign Language <br> Students must complete a full year of Latin. They must take two additional <br> years of a foreign language, whether in Latin or another language. | 1 in Latin |
| Composition and Rhetoric <br> Core course: Composition (1 semester) and Rhetoric (1 semester). <br> Depending upon the student's readiness for the standard course, a basic <br> composition course may be required, followed by the standard course. | 1 |
| Moral Philosophy <br> Core course: Moral Philosophy (1 semester) | .5 |
