Test	Date	Duration	Target Grade(s) / Purpose
<i>Federally Mandated:</i>			
WIDA Screener	August - October 1 (within 30 days of enrollment)	2.5 hours	WIDA Screener is an English Language Proficiency (ELP) assessment administered to students to help identify students who are English learners (ELs).
ACCESS for ELLs	January 11 - February 12	Approximately 2.25 hours	K-12 students who have been identified as English language learners; to monitor student progress in English language proficiency (ELP) on an annual basis and to serve as a criterion to aid in determining when ELLs have attained language proficiency comparable to that of their English-proficient peers.
<i>State Mandated:</i>			
Kindergarten Readiness Assessment	October, 2026	Data collected over multiple weeks.	Kindergarten; Measures basic skills that indicate readiness for school. Results used to determine if extra support is necessary.
CMAS (Colorado Measures of Academic Success): ELA and Math	April 5 - 14 (paper) April 5 - 23 (online)	4.5 hours	Grades 3-8; Measures student and school performance in English Language Arts and Math according to Colorado Academic Standards.



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CMAS (Colorado Measures of Academic Success): Science	April 5 - 23	1.5 hours	Grades 5, 8, and 11; CMAS measures student and school performance in Science according to Colorado Academic Standards.
CMAS (Colorado Measures of Academic Success): Social Studies	April 5 - 14 (paper) April 5 - 23 (online)	1.5 hours	Grades 4 and 7; CMAS measures student and school performance in Social Studies according to Colorado Academic Standards.
PSAT (Preliminary Standardized Academic Test)	April 21 - 22	Approximately 2.25 hours	Grade 9; Measures reading, writing, language, and math skills. Prepares students for SAT. Helps determine eligibility for National Merit Scholarship.
SAT (Scholastic Aptitude Test)	April 21 - 22		Grade 11; Measures reading, writing, language, and math skills. Students may use scores to demonstrate graduation competency.
READ Act Interims (Dibels 8)	September 8 - 18 (1-3) September 29 - Oct 9 (K) January 11 - 22 (K-3) April 26 - May 7 (K-3)	8 min/student	Administered three times in a school year. Measures reading comprehension and fluency (benchmark screener) for all students grades K-3. Optional: Schools may assess new students and returning students grades 4-6 score below benchmark the previous year.

Classic Learning Test (CLT)	September 15 - 18 (CLT 3-8) November 5 (CLT 10) November 14 (CLT) December 7 - 9 (CLT 3-8) March 29 - 31 (CLT 3-8)	2.5 hours	CLT is a diagnostic and/or end-of-grade assessment designed as an aid for school administrators, teachers, and parents as they help students achieve grade-level academic benchmarks. CLT 3 - 8 is administered to students in grades 3 through 8. CLT 10 is administered on an opt-in basis to students in grades 9 and 10. CLT is administered on an opt-in basis to students in grades 11 and 12



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Universal Screener for GT (CogAT)	November, 2026	3 hours	Grades 2 & 6; used to determine eligibility for gifted and talent Alternative Learning Plans (ALPs).
<i>Opt-in Exams Offered by ACA:</i>			
ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery)	September 16	3 hours	Grade 12; ASVAB is a timed multiple-choice test used by the United States military to determine enlistment eligibility and job assignments. A score of 31 or higher on the Armed Forces Qualification Test (AFQT) portion satisfies Colorado's high school graduation competency requirements for both English and math.
NMSQT (National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test)	October 17	2.25 hours	Grade 11; The NMSQT is a computer-based standardized test that measures reading, writing, and math skills while serving as the qualifying exam for the National Merit Scholarship Program. It can also be used to practice for the SAT.

The Ascent Classical Academy Charter Schools governing board has adopted Policy AP-13.0 and 13.1 concerning state assessments. Please see these policies in the Family Handbook for further detail. Summarized, all state mandated assessments are administered in paper-and-pencil format when possible. Parents or guardians may opt their children out of mandatory state assessments and the school will provide opt-out instructions. Students will not be subject to negative consequences for not taking these assessments, and the school will not engage in activities that discourage a student from taking a state assessment or that encourage parents or guardians to excuse students from testing.
